Solar Eclipse 2017/Parents

There will be a solar eclipse on Monday August 21st that will be visible in Palo Alto from approximately 9:15-11:15 a.m., with approximately 74% of the sun blocked by the moon around 10:15 a.m.! The Escondido community is very excited to experience this amazing natural phenomenon through indirect methods to keep our students and their eyesight safe. Looking directly at the sun can cause damage to the eye, and that is also true during an eclipse. Along with their teachers and staff, students will have the opportunity to watch the shadow of the moon on the ground at outside stations during morning recess. To make this an enjoyable and safe experience:

1. Join us! Please contact your child's teacher or the office if you would like to participate with us on campus that day. Sign in at the office before morning recess which begins at 10 a.m.
2. Emphasize to your child(ren) that they should NOT try to observe the eclipse by looking directly at the sun, not even for a brief glimpse. There's a chance damage to their eyes could happen quickly (and permanently).
3. Please contact your child's teacher/the office/the principal no later than Sunday evening if you want to opt them out of outside morning recess that day.
